Rotations Overview:

- Floors: 4.5-5 months rotation
 - Educational rounding model: Teams consist of hospitalist, senior resident, intern, +/- medical student
 - 2 General Medicine
 - 1 Telemetry
 - 1 Oncology
 - \circ Call is Q4 days and you only take call when on floors
- ICU/CCU/RRT
 - \circ MICU: One month rotation
 - Closed Unit
 - Amazing learning opportunities dedicated Attending / Fellow
 - Ultrasound teaching, procedure certifications, Plans for ECMO center
 - \circ CCU: One month rotation
 - Closed Unit
 - Exposure to all major cardiac conditions
 - Manage patients with swan catheters, balloon pumps
