



Match Day 2023 Results

Match Day 2023 marks the second cohort of NYU Grossman Long Island School of Medicine final-year students to participate in the National Resident Matching Program (NRMP). For the second consecutive year, 100 percent of the graduating class matched. Supporting our mission, 64 percent are entering primary care residencies, and an additional 24 percent are pursuing residencies in core disciplines. 36 percent will continue graduate training within the NYU Langone Health system.
