Application Information (last updated November 2019)

Before you complete the online application, please read through the following information: If accepted into the NYU Long Island School of Medicine Faculty Scholars program, you make the following commitments:

1. Attendance at in-person, instructional sessions held 1x each month *Email jeannine.nonailada@nyulangone.org for schedule
2. Participation in online activities (discussion boards, etc.)
3. Preparatory activities and readings outside of regular sessions.
4. Completion of: Departmental teaching plan for Educator Pathway or Independent educational research project for Researcher Pathway

In order for your application to be considered, the following documents must be submitted electronically with your completed application for NYU Long Island School of Medicine Faculty Scholars Program, so you'll want to have them prepared:

1. Current curriculum vitae (submit Word or pdf in online application).
2. Signed letter of commitment from your Department Chair/Division Chief, to include a statement of support for your program participation, attendance at scheduled instructional sessions and as-needed mentoring sessions for your projects (submit Word or pdf in online application).
3. -For applicants to the Educator Track: Personal statements of your educational philosophy and interests, and how the Faculty Scholars Program will advance your career as a medical educator.
-For applicants to the Researcher Track: Submission of research interest with formulated research question, rationale for choosing, and how the Faculty Scholars Program will advance your career as a researcher.
4. Uploaded copy of your successful completion certificate of CITI research training.
